

Badge Identification Requirements

TSA regulations require badge applicants to provide unexpired documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.*

Badge applicant must present:

ONE SELECTION FROM LIST A **OR ONE SELECTION FROM LIST B AND ONE SELECTION FROM LIST C**

List A- Documents that establish both Identity & Employment Authorization.

Please bring one of the following:

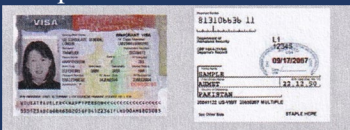
- U.S Passport or Card



- Permanent Resident Card



- Foreign Passport with I-551 stamp or I-94



- Employment Authorization Document (I-766)



*If you were born outside of the United States, you must provide one of the following:
U.S Passport, Permanent Resident card, Certificate of Naturalization or other List A

List B- Documents that establish Identity.

Please bring one of the following:

- State-issued Driver's license
- State-issued ID card
- Federal, State, or Local government-issued card



- U.S. Military Card



Two forms of Identification will not be accepted.

Pilot license, insurance card, or credit cards is not a List B or List C selection. They will not be accepted

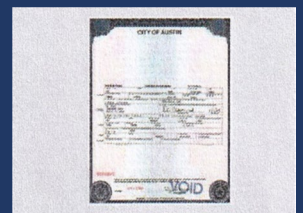
List C- Documents that establish Employment Authorization.

Please bring one of the following:

- U.S Social Security card (No restricted Social Security card)



- Certified Birth Certificate



- Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State, Forms DS-1350, FS-545 or FS-240
